Getting Certified: A checklist

The following items are standard requirements for obtaining a State of Alaska teaching license

- Fill & submit the application form Submit fee payment of \$200
- FBI Fingerprint & Background Check Background check \$60

Visit your local law enforcement agency to have your fingerprints rolled by a trained technician.

- Transcripts
 Include documentation from all attended higher education institutions.
- Provide evidence of successfully completed exams
 - Basic Competency Exam (PRAXIS)
 - Content Exam
- Demonstrate completion of a stateapproved teacher training program
- 6 Mandatory Trainings
 - Sexual abuse awareness
 - Alcohol or drug related disabilities
 - Dating violence awareness and prevention
 - Suicide awareness and prevention
