

Getting Certified: A checklist

The following items are standard requirements for obtaining a State of Alaska teaching license

1

Fill & submit the application form
Submit fee payment of \$200

2

FBI Fingerprint & Background Check
Background check \$60

Visit your local law enforcement agency to have your fingerprints rolled by a trained technician.

3

Transcripts
Include documentation from all attended higher education institutions.

4

Provide evidence of successfully completed exams

- Basic Competency Exam (PRAXIS)
- Content Exam

5

Demonstrate completion of a state-approved teacher training program

6

Mandatory Trainings

- Sexual abuse awareness
- Alcohol or drug related disabilities
- Dating violence awareness and prevention
- Suicide awareness and prevention
