
Totes are reusable and sturdy when shipping from the Lower 48 to your village site.

If you check these as part of your luggage, wrap in clear packing tape for the purpose of TSA security clearance. When shipping through USPS, we recommend drilling holes through the lid and securing with zip ties (see image).

Rubbermaid Roughneck totes rarely get damaged whereas other brands are known to crack or shatter during shipping.

Drill holes in the flap where the lid overlaps with the container on the outside



*Do NOT cut the length of the cable tie; this causes sharp ends and causes injury to the postal workers

**Point the length cable tie facing downwards





Pro Tip:

- 1. Totes can be brought empty from your village to BET or ANC for shopping/grocery trips
- 2. Secure heavy items so they don't bounce around and break other items
- 3. Don't forget about weight requirements
 - a. Airline checked bag weight restrictions
 - b. USPS- the heavier the tote, the more it costs to ship
